

Polling Methodological note – 8/8/2016



A sample of 1,199 adults in Great Britain were interviewed between the 5th and 8th August 2016. All interviews were conducted as online self-completion, using the Lightspeed GMI access panel as the sample source.

The data was weighted to match population totals for age, sex, working status, 2015 General Election voting patterns, education, region, and likelihood to vote in the next General Election. Further details on the weighting are given on page two.

Margin of error

The figures are estimates based on a sample of the population of Great Britain; this means that there is a degree of uncertainty around each estimate. On the assumption that – conditional on the weights - the sample is practically equivalent to a random sample, the survey estimates have a margin of error of up to ± 4 percentage points.

Weighting

Weights have been applied to the sample to ensure that it is representative of the general public in Great Britain aged 18+. The sources for the population totals are provided in each table.

Likelihood to Vote in General Election

We have estimated the likelihood that each respondent will vote in the next General Election. This value is based on respondents' stated intention to vote, their age and whether they voted in the last general election. The expected population turnout has been included as a population total in the weighting matrix. This turnout has been estimated based on the relationship between sample and population turnout rates in the 2015 general election.
